### **Size, Format, Font and Style:**

This year, RSC posters will be displayed on **digital poster boards**. As such, please **do not** print your poster.

To create your digital poster, please create this in the following measurements:

**Portrait: 1920\*1080 pixels or (60\*28) cm.**

Your poster file should be submitted as a **PNG or JPG**.

- Posters should include the title as submitted in your abstract
- Each poster should be readable from a distance of 1.5 - 2 meters
- Recommended line spacing is between 1.25 and 1.5

### **Timings of Presentation:**

You will have a total of **10 minutes** for your presentation and a follow-up Q&A:

**7 minutes** for presentation

**3 minutes** for Q&A

You **all must attend** your poster session from the beginning and stay until the end.
