Internet & Mobile Services

- Free Wi-Fi is widely available in hotels, cafés, and public spaces. Reliable mobile coverage throughout the city.
 - Prepaid SIM cards can be conveniently purchased at the airport as well as at major grocery chains such as Maxima, Rimi, and IKI. For those who prefer an eSIM option, the Saily app is a recommended choice.

Getting Around

From Vilnius Airport:

- **Train:**
Direct train between airport and railway station
Duration: ~7 minutes | Price: ~€0.80
- **Bus:**
Routes 1, 2, 88 (every 20–30 min), 3G (every 10 min)


To Conference Hotel

- By bus: 3G or 88 → Europos aikštė stop (≈50 m walk)
- By taxi: ~20 minutes

From Railway Station

- By bus: 1G → Žalasis tiltas stop
- By taxi: ~15 minutes

Public Transport

- E-ticket: JUDU / Vilniečio card (cost: €1.50)
- Contactless payment available onboard
- Free transfers within ticket validity

Other Options

- Ride-hailing: Bolt, Uber
- Taxis widely available (cash & card accepted)

Payments

- Cards and contactless payments accepted almost everywhere
 - Cash rarely needed, but useful in small amounts.

Emergency & Health

- **Emergency services.** In case of emergency, use the universal phone number **112**. Please note: this number should only be used for emergencies and never to obtain tourist or any other information.
 - Emergency and urgent care at hospitals is accessible for everyone. [More information and contacts here.](#)
 - EU visitors are advised to carry a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)
 - Pharmacies (“vaistinė”) are easy to find in the city

Electricity

- Plug types: **Type C & F (European standard)**
 - Voltage: **230V / 50Hz**
 - Visitors from countries using different plug types should bring an adapter

Weather

Weather in Vilnius can be variable, so we recommend dressing in layers.

Typical day temperatures during the conference period range from approximately **13°C to 18°C**.

Rain is possible, so make sure to have an umbrella or rain jacket.

Language

- Official language: Lithuanian
- English is widely spoken, especially in hotels, restaurants, and by younger people

A list of useful Lithuanian words and phrases that will help you to navigate in Lithuania with ease:

Labas (lah-bahs) – Hello

Ačiū (ah-choo) – Thank you

Prašom (prah-shom) – Please / You're welcome

Atsiprašau (ah-tsee-prah-shau) – Excuse me / I'm sorry

Malonu susipažinti (mah-loh-noo soo-see-pah-zheen-tee) – Nice to meet you

Taip (type) – Yes

Ne (neh) – No

Safety

Vilnius is considered a safe city for visitors.

As in any urban area, please take standard precautions and keep an eye on personal belongings in crowded places.

i Additional Information

- **Tipping:** Optional but appreciated (5–10% in restaurants)
- **Smoking:** Prohibited in indoor public spaces, smoking is allowed only in designated areas or outdoors.

- **Drinking water:** Safe from the tap. However, please follow any specific instructions provided in hotels and public areas.
